



Silver, mercury, cobalt, copper, lead and nickel - all this has been stoped in this mining-area. While your guidance through the galleries (1 hour) you will be in the ambience, where the miners spend the main time of their life with hard work. In the most show mines you will be carried by a railroad while your tour - not here in Leogang! You walk yourself throught the narrow galleries, from time to time ducked and in single file. Because of the puristic and nearly unmodified visitor zone you will be able to imagine the work at that time.

The view down the gypsum-pit reaches 30 meters.





At the end of your walk - after 3.500 years of mining history and an altitude difference of 50 meters - finally daylight again, and the roadhouse "Unterberghaus" offers you tasty regional food and cakes.
